- This year, the Festival coincides with the People's Climate March. In support of the March, many gardens will host workshops and teach-ins on a wide range of environmental issues.
- LUNGS is working closely with Converge for Climate to coordinate our own homegrown workshops and theirs. The NYC Climate Convergence is a weekend packed with skill-shares, teach-ins, speak-outs and protests from September 19 to 21 in conjunction with the People's Climate March.
- The gardens will also host fabulous performances in music, dance, theater, spoken word, on site visual artists, and more. One of the highlights of this year's Festival is a performance by Bread and Puppet Theater of their new piece "Anti Tar Sands Manifesto Pageant."
- On Sunday, the Festival gets on its feet as community gardeners and friends join the People's Climate March en masse.
